



Disposal of waste items NOT collected in Botanic rubbish bins

The **Community Recycling Centre in Artarmon** is a facility where residents in the local Lane Cove area can drop off problem household waste **free of charge**.

Examples of the type of items accepted by the centre:

- paint
- gas bottles
- fire extinguishers
- motor oils
- car and household batteries
- light tubes
- ink cartridges
- mobile phones
- computers
- printers
- televisions
- music players
- small electrical appliances
- X-ray films

The centre is easily accessible at 8 Waltham Street Artarmon.

Opening hours: Mondays, Tuesdays and Fridays from 8am to 2pm and weekends from 8am to 4pm.

Household Collections :

The method to have larger items removed from the premises is for the resident to contact the Lane Cove Council. Every local resident is eligible to arrange up to 4 **free household collections** per year. Pre-booking is essential. see www.lanecove.nsw.gov.au/CouncilServices/WasteandRecycling

Examples of items collected by booked Council pickups are:

- furniture
- furnishings
- bedding
- luggage
- white goods
- household and sporting goods
- packaging material (styrene foam, plastic sheeting and cardboard)

Charity shops in the Village take many “seconds” but not electrical. Charity clothing bins are also located in the Village.
